

RULES

1. The organisers and landowner do not accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or personal property.
2. No unauthorised person to enter rings
3. Protective hats and appropriate riding clothes must be worn.
4. No horse or pony under 4 years may enter any of the ridden classes.
5. The Judge's decision is final.
6. No illegal assistance by spectators.
7. No horse or pony to be ridden by more than one rider in any one event except clear round jumping.
8. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the offence and must be accompanied by £10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
9. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded due to cancellation by competitors (unless accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate).
10. Competitors who enter more than one class which may clash do so entirely at their own risk. Classes will not be held up and no entries will be refunded.
11. Age (where applicable) as on the day of the show.
12. Kingston Maurward College reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes and hold the prize money if insufficient entries.
13. The Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry or entries of any Person if they shall deem it fit to do so without reasons for doing so.
14. Anyone found galloping around the arenas will be asked to leave.
15. The Judge may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs. Whips over 30" in length are not allowed.
16. No lungeing.
17. Competitors who disobey any Judge or Official's decision could be refused entry in future Kingston Maurward College competitions.
18. Competitors are responsible for adhering to start times. Riders arriving late may be allowed to take part at the Judge's discretion.
19. In the event of adverse weather conditions, it is the competitor's responsibility to telephone the Event Secretary on 01305 215135 or Manor Stables on 01305 215063.
20. All dogs must be kept on lead.
21. The Competition will run under British Showjumping Rules & Regulations.

League tables will be updated throughout the series and the final 20 competitors with the highest number of points (at each height) will qualify for the Championships.

Rosettes: to sixth place in each class

All classes will be held in the indoor arena

Warm-up will be in the outdoor arena

Trailblazers provides unaffiliated competitors with an opportunity to qualify and compete at the Trailblazers Championship Finals. There is no membership fee, you just need to pay the entry fee in order to compete. Show Jumping is now a direct qualifier to the Championship Finals. The eight highest placed competitors in each of the Trailblazers qualifier classes will qualify directly to the Finals. If you are placed in the top eight and wish to enter the Finals you will need to purchase a qualification card from us (£12). The Finals will be held at the beautiful Stoneleigh Park in Warwickshire during the summer of 2020 (dates tbc). The aim of the Championship Finals is to provide competitors with all the buzz and excitement of a high profile championship, with the emphasis on quality, enjoyment, and creating a memorable experience.
