



KMC STUDENT CLOTHING 2022 / 2023

Different curriculum areas will have different requirements for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

You **MUST** wear this correctly for health and safety reasons and to maintain the bio-security of the campus. You will receive training in these requirements from your course teacher during Induction Week.

You will receive a copy of a Kit List which sets out appropriate industry standard work clothes which you need to wear during your time at the College. It is essential that you adhere to these clothing standards.

Where polo shirts are required, you may buy branded Kingston Maurward clothing. Whilst this is not compulsory, you must ensure that you wear a similar navy polo shirt alternative as described in the Kit List. Please note that brightly coloured polo shirts/tops are not considered to be an acceptable alternative to College branded clothing.

If you are a returning student, you will be able to wear last year's uniform if you do not wish to purchase new uniform.

Students will not be allowed to take part in College activities and duties wearing inappropriate clothing that does not meet industry standards – such as a vest top or crop tops.

Jewellery and piercings are to be removed and long hair must be tied back for ALL practical tasks; in order to maintain safety and bio-security, you must follow the direction of the teacher when undertaking practical tasks.

Students are expected to keep any Personal Protective Equipment in a clean and serviceable condition. Clothing should be washed regularly and tears or rips mended promptly.

Overalls and steel toe capped foot-wear must be worn for all practical sessions. Boots should be cleaned as required. Students in dirty boots may have to remove them before entering some parts of the College or using College transport. Boot wash areas are available near the Coach House Café and at Coneygar (Animal Welfare and Science building).

Branding clothing can be reserved / purchased at interview sessions, enrolment week and also from the LRC throughout the year. Personal Protective Equipment can be purchased from local retailers and your Course Manager can provide you with details of the recommended retailers.
