--- AGRICULTURE -

Students benefit from studying a broad range of topics delivered by industry experts. Students will learn more about all the jobs that may be available to them while they develop the knowledge and skills they need to succeed in roles including Farm Manager, Herdsperson, Land Management Advisor or Machinery Driver. The courses include practical sessions and talks with industry specialists and regular lessons on the College Farm, a commercial 300ha mixed farm with dairy, sheep and arable enterprises. The Farm surrounds the campus and allows students to get involved with activities from lambing and calf feeding, to tractor field work and wildlife surveys.

Level 1 Diploma

Learn the basic skills, knowledge and understanding of working in agriculture and the countryside and prepare for employment or progression to a more advanced course, or an apprenticeship. The level 1 programme offers a broad range of subjects and practical skill development.

Level 2 Diplomas

These courses provide the opportunity to learn about the husbandry of crops, livestock, estate skills and farm machinery operation; or specialise in vehicle engineering and maintenance. Knowledge, practical skills and industry networking are gained from both college studies and work experience within the agricultural industry.

Level 3 Diploma and T levels

These courses support the development of a wide range of specialist technical practical skills and detailed knowledge covering arable, livestock, machinery, and industry-relevant units. The Agriculture, Land Management and Production T Level covers core aspects of business and safe working practices, alongside occupational specialisms in either land-based engineering, livestock production, or arable crop production. Industry work experience is also essential.

ANIMAL WELFARE AND SCIENCE

Our extensive onsite animal collection houses over 100 species of animals including reptiles, amphibians, small mammals, birds, tropical and freshwater fish, and invertebrates. During their time at College, learners will handle, health check and complete husbandry tasks on a range of these species. Opportunities in our Animal Park also allow learners to develop their confidence with hoofed stock, poultry and birds of prey.

Level 1 Diploma

This one-year course will give you the opportunity to develop your knowledge, practical skills and team-working by working with a range of animal species in our animal collection. All lessons are underpinned by safe working practices and the development of employability skills.

Level 2 Diploma

This course contains a mixture of theory lessons, demonstrations, projects and practical work involving our onsite animal collection. The course also requires you to complete at least 150 hours of work experience with an external employer within the animal care industry.

Level 3 Diploma or T Level

These courses support the development of specialist technical practical skills and detailed knowledge spanning all aspects of animal welfare, husbandry, biology, and exotic and native wildlife species, alongside working within our onsite animal collection. The Animal Care and Management T Level covers an exciting range of industry relevant topics. Industry work experience is also essential to develop employability skills.



— CONSTRUCTION —

You will work with guest lecturers and vocational experts, and take part in work experience that develops your employability skills. You will then have the opportunity to put what you have learnt into practise.

The teaching team work with numerous local employers and have built a strong reputation for producing high quality and highly employable students at the end of their study programme.

Level 1 Diploma

A keen interest in the broad range of construction areas is needed for this one year course and the study programme covers a range of construction skills. This includes plumbing installation, carpentry, joinery, brickwork, blockwork, electrical work, renewing and refitting radiators, and more.

Level 2 Diploma

Our Construction Maintenance Operations course builds on the skills and knowledge developed at Level 1 and uses a mixture of practical and theory sessions, online assessments and practical assessments to cover a diverse range of topics reflecting local industry requirements. Our students work towards building repairs, painting and decorating, paving, scaffolding, plumbing, roofing, plastering, carpentry/joinery and more. This enables our learners to be multiskilled employable or choose to take a specialist apprenticeship as they progress after their course.

Level 3 T Level

Level 3 T level, this two year qualification is centred on the construction industry. You will cover topics such as; health and safety, construction science, and sustainability in the construction industry. A 315-hour industry work placement is a compulsory element. You will choose one specialism from: Bricklaying, Carpentry and Joinery, Painting and Decorating, or Plastering.

EQUINE STUDIES

You will be working with employers and industry experts, taking part in yard duties, assisting with running our competitions and have the opportunity to take part in work experience each year to develop your employability skills. There are pathway options available at each level for each course, depending on your career goals and this can be discussed further at your interview. The department does have a weight limit of 85kgs for all riders and riding assessments will take place in the first week of college.

Level 1 Diploma

This one year course is an ideal introduction for school leavers wishing to start their career working with horses whilst studying towards a grade 4 in English and maths GCSE. You will study equine health, welfare, feeding, estate skills, lungeing, and take part in training days at Manor Stables and undertake work experience. On successful completion you can move on to a Level 2 qualification.

Level 2 Diploma

This course is an excellent choice for those that have some experience of equitation and horse care. There are ridden and grooms' pathways on this one-year course. You will need to have a genuine passion for horses and be prepared to work hard to develop your knowledge and skills, equipping you for a rewarding career in the equine industry. You will study health, biology, stable duties, work experience, preparation and plaiting, and riding or behaviour. On successful completion you can move forward to a level 3 qualification.

Level 3 Diplomas

If you have the drive to work in the equine industry or wish to progress on to higher education you will need to gain outstanding knowledge and skills in all aspects of a ridder or yard manager pathway. This two year course will prepare you for moving forward with your chosen career. Specialist units include groundwork, ridden work, fitness, nutrition event management, yard management, health disease, rehabilitation and behaviour, and more.

HORTICULTURE, GARDENING & LANDSCAPING

All our horticulture courses embrace modern plant husbandry practices and garden design to create, maintain and protect both public and private spaces, and landscapes.

Level 1 Diploma

A one year course combining a mixture of theory and practical, this is a very hands-on qualification ideally suited to someone who is new to college learning and wishes to investigate a career in horticulture and study further. No previous knowledge is required, instead a willingness to learn new skills and develop knowledge of the world of land-based work and horticulture.

Level 2 Diploma

This one year course is an ideal entry point for school leavers. It is designed to build on your natural enthusiasm and give you a broad understanding of the basic principles and practices of horticulture including garden design and landscaping, planting and pruning, machinery, science and plant identification.

Level 3 Diploma and T Level

At Level 3, the Advanced Technical Extended Diploma in Horticulture provides in-depth knowledge of horticultural principles & practices including plant identification, management of designed and natural spaces, surveying, garden design, and history. A T Level in Ornamental Horticulture, Environment, and Landscaping offers core units including business & project management and the establishment, maintenance and installation of soft and hard landscapes.

We are also the only college in Dorset with a Combined Cadet Force, (CCF), which is fully affiliated to the Wessex Yeomanry.

WELDING, FABRICATION & BLACKSMITHING

This course will develop skills in both blacksmithing and welding whilst you work towards a recognised qualification. You will be able to learn from skilled and expert staff whilst working in a well-equipped forge and welding bays to develop the skills and knowledge to move forwards with an apprenticeship, Level 3 qualification or employment.

WELDING, FABRICATION & BLACKSMITHING

During the course you will develop your knowledge on Manual Metal Arc (MMA) and Metal Inert Gas (MIG) welding. You will learn to set up and to use the equipment safely in welding booths which are all equipped with extraction units. You will also learn further fabrication skills such as, gas cutting and gas welding, safe use of the forge, safe use of tools and equipment, blacksmithing techniques, your knowledge of metals and their uses for different applications in manufacturing. You will also need to have a good knowledge of maths as you need to calculate areas of shapes, volumes and surface areas of shapes. A high degree of Health and Safety is observed in all workshops, where students will form their own risk assessments.

Level 2 Diploma

This one year study programme thoroughly covers Welding and Thermal Cutting Processes, The Forging Process, Metallurgy and Heat Treatment, Technical and Freehand Techniques, Researching, Designing and Making Blacksmith Products, Fabrication Techniques and Forge Work and Construction Techniques. Work experience is included with a local employer and guest speakers co-deliver your course.

Level 3 Diploma

This two year study programme will challenge the learners to develop skills and knowledge in key technical areas such as Understanding Detailed Workshop Practice for Blacksmithing and Metalworking, Using Forging Techniques, Undertaking Drawing Practice and Design, Welding and Fabrication along with Business Management. You will have the opportunity to work and network with local employers, take part in work-experience and be taught by industry experts.

Level 1 Diploma

Gain knowledge and practical skills needed for working with trees and careers in forestry, arboriculture, or related environmental fields. 
Level 3 Diplomas and T Level

PLACEMENTS

If you are required to complete an industry placement as part of your course, you will be expected to gain a minimum of 315 hours, with an external employer, in a role directly relevant to your course. Industry placement hours can be gained over two academic years and are compulsory for some of our T Level courses: Agriculture, Animal Welfare & Science, Business Studies, Construction, Horticulture and Wildlife Ecology & Conservation.

A longer duration ensures that you are given sufficient time to master essential skills and develop your technical abilities to industry standard. They allow you to put into practice the theory and skills you are learning in the classroom. Completing an industry placement will give you a competitive advantage to securing skilled employment in the future.





Diplomas give students the knowledge and skills they need to ultimately progress to university or move straight into employment and are well-recognised by universities and employers.

T-LEVELS



T Levels are 2-year qualifications that you can do after GCSEs as an alternative to A levels, other post-16 courses or an apprenticeship.

They have been designed with leading businesses and employers to give you the knowledge and skills you need.

T Level courses are for 16-19 year olds who have completed their GCSEs.

You'll spend 80% of your time in the classroom and 20% on a minimum 45-day industry placement with an employer to give you the skills and knowledge companies look for.

Your industry placement gives you the chance to learn what a real career is like while you continue your studies. When and how you complete it depends on the T Level, school or college, and employer.

Like A levels, there are no tuition fees to study a T Level if you start before you are 19.

Your T Level will be worth UCAS points and will be recognised by universities and other education providers so you can choose to continue studying if you wish.

T Level Distinction* = 3 A levels at A*

If you are interested in doing a T Level course, please go to the course-specific page and look for an option with T Level in the title.

When you pass your T Level, you will get a nationally recognised certificate showing the overall grade you achieved - pass, merit, distinction or distinction*.

It will also give details of what you learned on the course to help you move into skilled employment or a higher apprenticeship.

REQUIREMENTS

We offer different levels of programmes within each subject area so there is a starting point for everyone and importantly a progression route too. These range from Entry Level to Level 3 Extended Diplomas and T Levels

Entry Level:

No formal qualifications required but students should have a desire to work outdoors in a variety of land-based subjects.

We will also need full details of any special educational needs and reports from relevant bodies or establishments to ensure that we are able to put the correct level of support in place for each learner.

Level 1:

Entry requirements are flexible and depend on each individual subject area. Generally 2 - 4 GCSE grades at 1 / 2 or E / F will be accepted.

Level 2:

Generally 4 GCSEs at grade 3 / D or equivalent including English and maths.

Level 3:

Generally 4 GCSEs at grades 9-4 / A* to C or equivalent including English and maths. Please note: accepted qualifications are derived from those recognised in School Performance Tables. If you hold alternative qualifications e.g. iGCSEs, please discuss this with the Student Administration Team on 01305 215034.
