

GLOSSARY OF TERMS	
AT RISK	Students who are at risk of not progressing onto a positive destination, for example further study or employment
CEIAG	This stands for careers education, information, advice and guidance . All students are entitled to receive this support throughout their time at KMC
EHCP	This stands for Education Health and Care Plan - a document which sets out the education, healthcare and social care needs of young person for whom extra support is needed in college
EMPLOYER ENGAGEMENT EMPLOYER ENCOUNTERS	<p>Meaningful employer engagement includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A workplace visit • An employer visiting the college • It doesn't include work experience • There will be at least two encounters during one academic year • One encounter should also be STEM related <p>Employer encounters should be different at each level of study i.e. Level 1 students in a vocational area should not include visiting the same employer at Level 2 or Level 3 as a meaningful employer encounter</p>

HE	Higher education , study programmes that can be at are Level 4 and above. At level 6, another term for university
LABOUR MARKET INFORMATION (LMI)	National data that is used to inform and support individuals when making decisions about careers
LRC	Learning Resource Centre (also known as the library)
PROGRESSION ROUTES	This term refers to the multiple options available for students after completing a study programme at KMC. Examples include apprenticeships, university and entering employment
SOUTHERN UNIVERSITIES NETWORK (SUN)	A number of HE providers in Hampshire, Dorset and the Isle of Wight providing outreach activities for schools and colleges as part of Uni Connect
STEM	This stands for science, technology, engineering and mathematics
UCAS	The Universities and Colleges Admissions Service is a UK-based organisation whose main role is to operate the application process for British universities
UNIT-E	The internal data management system that we use to record student information
