RULES

- The organiser and landowner do not accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or personal property.
- 2. No unauthorised persons to enter arenas.
- 3. Protective hats and appropriate riding clothes must be worn.
- 4. No horse or pony under four years may enter any of the classes.
- 5. The Judge's decision is final.
- 6. No illegal assistance by spectators.
- 7. The competition will run in accordance with British Dressage rules.
- 8. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the offence and must be accompanied by £10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
- 9. If a competitor withdraws, entry fees can only be refunded if a veterinary certificate / doctors note is provided.
- 10. Competitors who enter more than one class which may clash do so entirely at their own risk.
- 11. Age (where applicable) as on the day of the show.
- 12. The organiser reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes and hold the prize money if insufficient entries.
- 13. The organiser reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry of any person if they deem it fit to do so.
- 14. Anyone found galloping around arenas will be asked to leave.
- 15. The Judge may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs.
- No lungeing.
- 17. Competitors who disobey any Judge or Official's decision could be refused entry in future competitions.
- 18. Competitors are responsible for adhering to their start times. Riders arriving late may be allowed to take part at the Judge's discretion.
- 19. All dogs must be kept on a lead and cleaned up after.
