

RULES

1. The organiser and landowner do not accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or personal property.
2. No unauthorised persons to enter arenas.
3. Protective hats and appropriate riding clothes must be worn.
4. No horse or pony under four years may enter any of the classes.
5. The Judge's decision is final.
6. No illegal assistance by spectators.
7. No horse or pony to be ridden by more than one rider in any one class, except clear round jumping.
8. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the offence and must be accompanied by £10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
9. If a competitor withdraws, entry fees can only be refunded if a veterinary certificate / doctors note is provided.
10. Competitors who enter more than one class which may clash do so entirely at their own risk.
11. Age (where applicable) as on the day of the show.
12. The organiser reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes if insufficient entries.
13. The organiser reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry of any person if they deem it fit to do so.
14. Anyone found galloping around arenas will be asked to leave.
15. Whips must be 'baton' style and measure between 45cm and 70cm in length. The Judge may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs.
16. No lungeing.
17. Competitors who disobey any Judge or Official's decision could be refused entry in future competitions.
18. Competitors are responsible for adhering to their start times. Riders arriving late may be allowed to take part at the Judge's discretion.
19. All dogs must be kept on a lead and cleaned up after.

This competition includes a qualifying opportunity for the 2026 Junior Battens Final at the Melplash Show on Thursday 27 August 2026. Rider eligibility – not to have reached 17th birthday by the date of the final. Open to ponies and horses. It is the rider and pony / horse combination which qualifies. To qualify, a clear round must be achieved in the first section. Those already qualified are disregarded for qualification purposes.
