Farm Life:

Key Stage 1

Objectives:

- Identify and name various animals, classifying them as 'farm' and 'non-farm' animals
- Identify and name various young animals; acknowledge the role that mothers play
- Acknowledge that farms provide us with food, both from animals and plants

Key Stage 2

Objectives:

- Identify why nutrition is important & how the basic function of the digestive system
- Look at and compare predators and prey including humans (looking at teeth also)
- Use various classes to group living things and identify common characteristics
- Recognise how living things rely on environments
- Explore reproduction and describe changes as animals develop

Key Stage 3 & 4

Objectives:

- Describing the importance of a healthy diet in animals & the consequences of poor nutrition (inc. the effects on humans as part of the food chain)
- Exploring in more detail the reproduction cycles of farm animals and the importance of observing these
- Explore health and disease in farm animal and its consequences on farming
